In one of the more muddled criminal cases pursued by the San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office over the last several decades, prosecutors are on the brink of throwing the case against a deputy accused of frolicking with an outlaw motorcycle out in total or large part in an effort to avoid the deputy's defense attorney's demands that the evidence implicating the

An apparent major issue for the prosecution is the sheriff's department's unwillingness to compromise certain means and methodologies employed by the department's command echelon and the detectives attached to it in surveilling, monitoring and investigation the department's employees.

Robertson Ending Steady & Easy 7 Years As AV Town Manager

When Apple Valley Town Manager Doug Robertson retires in December, he will have spent 7 years and 11 months as the town's top staff member. That duration as city manager one year, four months and a week shorter than the average town administrators in the 75,040 population, 77.08-square mile jurisdiction, which

Halstenberg's **Conviction On** Line Fire **Arson Counts Nets Him** Sixteen Years

Justin Wayne Halstenberg, who was convicted in May of having set the Line Fire in Highland on September 5, 2024, after which charred 43,978acre acres in its infernal progression north and eastward up into the San Bernardino Mountains wreaking more than \$100 million in destruction and damage for more than a month, was sentenced to 16 years to life in state prison on Wednesday, October 1.

Using self-styled incendiary devices, Halstenberg made three attempts at starting fires in the area of east Highland on September 5, 2025, according to prosecutors. Two of those fires failed to take hold, one when it burned out after burning less than ten square feet of vegetation that was not dry enough to fully ignite because it was irrigated regularly and another because a passerby good Samaritan stomped it out before it could spread. The last of the fires that arson investigators testified Halstenberg lit, however, grew into a major conflagration.

Almost miraculously, despite wending a fiery path through 68.71 square miles including within and very near to populated areas, no lives were lost and a mere six structures and a water conveyance pipeline destroyed, in large measure due to the massive response of firefighters to the periphery of the blaze. Six of those firefighters were injured during operations.

What is now believed is that two district employees affiliated with the nutrition services division in 2023 grew suspicious about monetary pass-throughs and reimbursements the district had received for purchases, some of which had not been made. Initially, their separate reports wound up the chain of command on different paths, involving two school principals. By July 2023, Avila learned of the issue when several district employees were airing complaints about what they said was Rahman-Davies' disproportional display of anger toward them when they made inquiries about missing food supplies. Avila did not have specific information upon which to act at that time, but he initiated an audit of the district's nutrition department.

Avila did not fully appreciate the connection between Rahman-Davies, who had acceded to the position of nutrition services director in 2019 and Maria Montes Torres, School board Member Edgar Montes' mother, who had been employed as a nutrition department worker with

As the audit and parallel investigation of the nutrition services division progressed, it was learned that food, sometimes in bulk and sometimes in smaller quantities, was not being utilized in the school lunch program but was being diverted to other uses, including by charities that were in no way affiliated with the school district, churches and mosques as well as to district employees.

Sarah Dunbar-Riley, a nutrition services supervisor, was able to offer specific information about diversions, including data regarding food that had been ordered and delivered to some schools but which had not been served to students as part of the lunch program. Reports reached Avila that on multiple occasions going back at least to 2020, no fewer than seven individuals had participated in removing substantial quantities of food from the warehouse adjacent to the district's central kitchen into their personal vehicles. Among those participating in this were Rahman-Davies; Kristina Kraushaar, a district employee who held the title of child nutrition program innovator; and Maria Rangel, who was employed by the district as assistant nutrition services director, as well as Maria Montes Torres, Avila learned.

According to Avila, when Edgar Montes,

known for the ability to track down and deliver specialized firearms, as well as for providing servicing and augmenting equipment to those products, along with, as the shop's name implied, all order of tactical gear, including knives, bulletproof wear and helmets, ammunition, magazines, cartridges, powders, primers, sights and scopes and all order of other accessories. Bingham was also attracted to motorcycling. The Mongols are one of the dominant motorcycle clubs in San Bernardino County, and Bingham gravitated to it, on occawhom Avila described as a "close friend" of Rahman-Davies, learned of the audit and side-byside investigation, the school board member grew irate. Directly and without informing the other members of the school board, scheduling a discussion of the matter either in pubic or in a closed session of the board or conducting a vote, Montes ordered Avila to discontinue the audit and investigation. When Avila did not comply, Montes again and again instead that the investigation be close out, according to Avila.

Thereafter, Avila was accused of sexual harassment by Patricia Chavez, who had been the principal at Wilmer Amina Carter High School and was also the district's assistant superintendent for educational services and its so-called lead agent of innovation. It was Chavez's accusations of sexual harassment that formed the basis of Montes', Dominguez' and O'Kelley's May 8 2024 vote to suspend him. After leaving Avila hanging in limbo for more than nine months, the school board on February 19, 2025 voted to terminate him.

During Avila's suspension, the district had promoted Edward D'Souza, who served up until May 2024 as the district's so-called lead academic agent for math and early college programs, to serve as the district's acting superin-

sion riding with its members, despite the group having been classified by law enforcement as a criminal motorcycle gang.

There is a degree of mystery as to whether the sheriff's department, or at least elements within it, were, for investigative purposes, making use of Bingham's entrée with members of the Mongols or those in the Morongo Valley community who, for whatever reasons legitimate or illegitimate, were arming themselves.

Despite certain indicators or evidence to the contrary, the sheriff's department and the district tendent.

D'Souza, who was the entertaining notion of seeing his temporary position as insuperintendent terim being upgraded into a full-fledged and permanent post, was aware of how Avila's direction in commissioning the audit and accompanying investigation had rattled Edgar Montes. Accordingly, D'Souza prudently sought to avoid antagonizing Montes, who could count on the support of Dominguez, who is Montes' most steadfast ally on the school board. D'Souza suspended the probe of the disappearance of the food.

In the meantime, O'Kelley, who had been experiencing extensive health challenges including memory and cognitive degradation, did not seek reelection to the board in the November 2024 election, and Dakira Williams was voted into office and replaced her in December.

Edgar Montes' effort to permanently bury the investigation into the food diversions failed when the school board, by a vote of 3-to-2, with members Stephanie Lewis, Joseph Martinez and Williams prevailing, opted against permanentizing D'Souza as the superintendent, instead returning him to his former role as the district's lead academic agent of math and early college programs in education services.

The board, again by a 3-to-2 vote with Lewis,

attorney's office have officially maintained since Bingham's arrest in 2024 that his interaction with the Mongols was a secret he kept to himself. That official line is contradicted, at least in part, by certain known facts. Martinez and Williams coming out on top, voted to hire Judy White, the former Riverside County superintendent of schools and deputy superintendent of schools with the San Bernardino City Unified School District, to lead Rialto Unified.

In one of her first acts as superintendent, White reinitiated the investigation that had been suspended under D'Souza's watch.

Almost immediately, on February 26, Kraushaar resigned to take a position as the food services director for the Chaffey Joint Union High School district.

With the resumption of the investigation and the audit, it was soon documented that at some the schools, discrepancies existed with regard to how much food was delivered and how many actual meals produced or provided. Data showed outright falsification of

ment for years appeared to accept, that such items were being sold, as Bingham stated publicly on-line, to "individual California law enforcement officers properly licensed and permitted to carry them or out of state buyers."

Bingham fastidiously adhered to the law with regard to regulations about whom guns can be sold to. At one point, in 2019, the sheriff's department's internal affairs division, referred to as professional standards, initiated an investigation into Bingham when it was alleged that he was improperly using

breakfast and lunch meal counts in single months exceeding two thousand at some elementary schools and more than 12,000 at a district high school. Other data showed the district being remunerated by the federal government for tens of thousands of meals that had not been served.

On April 16, 2025, Maria Montes Torres, Edgar Montes' mother, submitted her resignation as a district employee. A public relations blitz around her departure suggested that she was leaving because her hiring by the district had been an "inadvertent" technical violation of the district's ethical and nepotism restrictions when Board Member Montes had voted to ratify her promotion from being a substitute nutrition worker to a full-fledged district employee in the nutrition services division in September 2023.

For many, that sobriquet was idiosyncratic to the point of being intelligible. It involves an allusion or reference to the 1986 movie "Top Gun." The source for the name is part of the dialogue of the character played by Tom Cruise, maverick, in which he says, "It's time to buzz the tower."

Upon hearing the name for the first time, few understood the allusion. Indeed, a good number of people associated "buzzers" to mean those who, in slang parlance, "get a buzz," i.e.,

become slightly intoxicated by smoking some marijuana or drinking a couple of beers.

Many people, in particular that part of the population born since the 1980s or even some born in the 1980s or before, have not seen the movie Top Gun, have no knowledge regarding the movie or do not remember the line if they have seen the movie. Adding to the confusion is that the team mascot is to be named Maverick and will exist in the form of a bee, which is supposed to buzz.

It is said that members

of the Ontario International Airport Authority, who include President Alan Wapner and board members/commissioners Curt Hagman, Jim Bowman, Ron Loveridge and Julia Gouw, considered and rejected The Jets, The Airplanes, The Aeroplanes, The Top Guns, The Airfield and The Tarmac before settling on The Buzzers.

Some Ontario residents, inspired by the earlier report that a naming contest was being held, and hearing that the name buzzers was being considered, came forward with some

competing suggestions of their own. One, who had misheard buzzers as buzzards, countered with "The Vultures." Some others sought to get into the spirit by suggesting "The Stoners" and "Las Cucarachas."

The last two names suggested were made after someone observed that "The Buzzers" was perceived by some to be a reference paying homage to the team's fans, who would be too stoned to play on the Ontario Sports Empire's athletic fields as in the song lyrics, "La Cucaracha no puede caminar, porque

no tiene, porque te falta, marihuana que fumar.

It was pointed out that the president of the Ontario International Airport Authority Board of Directors is Ontario Councilman Alan Wapner. Wapner for 15 years, ten months and two days was employed as a police officer in Ontario. It is estimated that, given the 1982 to 1998 era that he was involved in law enforcement, he spent nearly 15 percent of his time involved in cases that either directly or indirectly involved marijuana, which was then illegal. in 2007 to succeed Bruce Williams who had been Apple Valley's original town manager, remaining in that post for the town's first 19 years.

Of some note is that both Cox and Robertson had made their respective marks on the world as city managers in Victorville before they signed on to oversee Apple Valley.

Marginally smaller geographically than Apple Valley at 74.16 square miles, Victorville is of substantially greater population density, with 141,689 residents currently. Moreover, it is host to Southern California Logistics Airport, a major aerodrome that was converted to civilian use from the former George Air Force Base. Victorville, traditionally and currently, has had a budget that dwarfs that of Apple Valley, as exemplified by the city's current expenditures of \$377 million in 2025-26 in comparison to the town's \$140 million. While Victorville is adiacent to Apple Valley, the pace of life is slower and the intensity of activity far less demanding in Apple Valley than in Victorville.

When Cox, eight years after he retired as Victorville City manager in 1999 agreed to take on the Apple Valley managerial role, he openly stated that he was willing to accept the burden only because he was certain that watching over Apple Valley would not be as demanding as running Victorville had been during the three decades he done so when he was many years younger than he was then. Cox left as Apple Valley Town manager in 2009, but was talked into returning to manage Victorville later that year when the manager who had succeeded Cox a decade before.

John Roberts, found himself overwhelmed by the city's financial challenges.

In 2017, Victorville was paying him \$270,292 in salary, in perquisites and other pay add-ons plus \$60,197.15 in benefits for a total annual compensation of \$393,812.15.

In accepting the Apple Valley position, he took something of a pay cut, as his salary with the town in 2018 was \$233,914, augmented with \$4,208 in perquisites and pay add-ons, and 57,083.07 in benefits for a total annual compensation of \$296,502.07, which was nearly \$100,000 less altogether than he was making in Victorville.

The reduction in tension, however, was worth it, Robertson figured.

Over the seven years he has been in Apple Valley, his pay has risen to \$284,496 in salary, \$33,895 in perks and pay add-ons, and \$60,282.45 in benefits for a total annual compensation of \$378,673.45, closer to but less than he was making in Victorville.

Robertson's successor as city manager in Victorville, Keith Metzler, meanwhile, has a total annual compensation package of \$486,654.17, consisting of \$343,394.23, \$26.229 in perquisites and pay addons and \$117,030.94 in benefits.

Under Robertson, as was the case under Robinson, Cox and Williams, there was tremendous stability in Apple Valley. Open dissension on the council was relatively rare and raucous displays with regard to public issues in the town generally unheard of. Exceptions to this oc-

In this way, the Mongols tolerate or indulge those they catalog as a "hangaround," someone who expresses a desire to join the motorcycle club but has yet been given official status a member. In this way, the would-be member is permitted to attend club rallies and events, and is allowed to join with the club on certain rides. While yet considered a hangaround, the applicant is expected to take up a place of the least prestige in the caravan of cyclists during a ride and is expected to be the first to pull over and submit to ticketing by the Highway Patrol or other law enforcement agencies if such official intervention by the authorities takes place on the freeway, highways or streets. Moreover, hangarounds are also given custody of any contraband that is being transported, such that he can show his loyalty to the Mongols by being subject to arrest and prosecution instead of having such a burden fall on the club's existing members in good standing. It is only after serving obediently in the lesser role of a hangaround for such a duration and under such conditions as the Mongols' leadership deems appropriate that the hanbership into the Mongols and given full-fledged

There appears to be no dispute that by 2023 and more likely by 2022 or perhaps even as early as 2021, Bingham had achieved the status of a hangaround with the Mongols. Available inindicates. formation however, that he had not yet been fully initiated into the Mongol organi-

At a yet undisclosed point in 2022 or 2023, some of Bingham's colleagues in the department grew concerned about his association and/or comportment, extending to his handling of the department's firearms inventory and association with the Mongols. The suspicions around Bingham had resulted, at least as early as the winter of 2023/24 if not earlier, in members of the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department surveilling Bingham, both while he was at work and off the clock.

On March 23, 2024, Bingham was off duty. That morning, San Bernardino County Sheriff's Deputy Robert Stucki had been detailed to follow him. It is believed, but has not yet been entirely established, that some order of a tracking device had been affixed to Bingham's Harley Davidson. Stucki followed Bigham, who was wearing a dark jacket, at a safe distance to ensure that Bingham did not know he was being followed. In Yucca Valley, Bingham met up with two Mongols, likewise on their Harley Davidsons, one of whom was known among the Mongols as "Nightmare Berdoo." Bingham and the two other cyclists headed south on Highway 62 to the I-10 Freeway west, having previously crossed into Riverside County. Stucki contacted the California Highway Patrol dispatch center for assistance. As Bingham and his two companions were approaching Highland Springs Road in Beaumont, they were spotted by two CHP officers - Sergeant Scott

Beauchene and Officer Teodora Blanco – who had been alerted to be on the lookout for them. The trio were pulled over, ostensibly for exceeding the speed limit. When the two other Mongols were out of earshot, Bingham informed Beauchene that he was a law enforcement officer and was armed. Beauchene would later testify that given the circumstance and Bingham's status as a law enforcement officer, he was prepared to simply issue Bingham a citation for speeding along with his two biking partners and allow him to leave. Shortly thereafter, however, Stucki arrived on the scene. Stucki, who was not in uniform, placed Bingham under arrest and entrusted him to the custody of Blanco. who transported him to the Larry D. Smith Correctional **Facility** in Banning. The other two motorcyclists were cited for speeding and allowed to leave. At the Riverside County detention facility in Banning, Bingham was booked on suspicion of being a gang member carrying a loaded firearm. While Bingham was being held, Riverside sheriff's department custody officers at Beauchene's behest ran a registration on the handgun he was carrying - a Glock 9 mm - through the State of California Department of Justice's database. It came up as unregistered. On the strength of Bingham being in the presence of two outlaw motorcycle gang members at the time of his arrest, his arrest on suspicion of being a gang member in possession of a gun, that he was in possession of what was represented to the judge as an unlicensed firearm and other particulars, Stucki and other investigators with the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department were able to obtain a search warrant from a San Bernardino County judge to search Bingham's home on Adobe

Road in Twentynine

ing of his bail, which, following a several hours long ordeal, resulted in his being released from the Riverside Sheriff's Department's custody later that day. Before he arrived home, investigators initiated a search of Bingham's home while his wife was present. They found 157 firearms, including a modified, fully automatic assault rifle with an attached grenade launcher, a customized AR-15 assault rifle with a 12-inch barrel, gun silencers, two explosive projectile devices, and a Remington 870 shotgun that had been altered to shoot nonlethal beanbags. In addition, they found what the department later described as "Mongols paraphernalia," which included a leather vest with Mongols patches, Mongols T-shirts, stickers and emblems, along with the motorcycle club's literature and publications. When the investigators pressed his wife with questions as to whether their home was a meetup place for Mongols, she told them that no motorcycle gang members had ever been to or inside the house. Investigators in putting together an arrest warrant for Bingham that was served on April 4, 2024 stated that the altered Remington 870 was sheriff's department property, which Bingham had stolen. arrest warrant The specified 10 felony counts against him. He was placed into protective custody inside the sheriff's department's West Valley Detention Center in Rancho Cucamonga, where he was held in lieu of \$500,000

Sheriff Shannon Dicus after Bingham's arrest put out a statement distancing the department from Bingham and decrying his "unacceptable" relationship with the Mongols.

Bingham, yet in jail, was able to retain attorney Jeff Moore to represent him. Bingham remained jailed throughout his preliminary hearing,

which took place over the course of three days in April 2024. Moore aggressively filed motions and contesting all of the questionably contexted or based assertions made by the prosecutor on the case, Deputy District Attorney Alberto Juan.

While Juan came into

the preliminary hearing

presided over by Judge

Alexander Martinez in

what to the outside world appeared to be a strong position, with advance publicity demonizing Bingham as a law enforcement officer who was leading a double-life as an outlaw gang member with hundreds of unlicensed and illegal firearms in his possession with which he was acting as an armorer to the criminal underworld, the case against the deputy, when cast in the glare of Moore's inquiries, showed itself to be embarrassingly thin as to be non-existent. Juan used the testimony of Sergeant Josh Guerry, Detective Joshua Gile and Detective Jeremy Spinney to focus the court's attention on Bingham's undeniable connection with members of the Mongols, essentially a strategy of guilt by association, as in "actively associating with a criminal gang." Juan referenced communications between Bingham and some Mongols members that took place on Bingham's Instagram account or through text messages that forensic experts had extracted from two cellphones investigators had seized during the search of Bingham's home. Juan suggested those exchanges, even though they referenced nothing that was specifically illegal, were yet highly improper. Among the several examples of Bingham's comportment that did not rise to the level of actual criminality which Juan successfully utilized to assassinate Bingham's reputation was a text exchange between Bingham and Nightmare Berdoo, who was riding with Bingham on March 23 and was cited for speeding and released when Bingham had been taken

into custody. In that exchange, Bingham opined that the law enforcement profession - meaning police officers and sheriff's deputies - qualified as being the "biggest gang in California."

Juan made much of Bingham's fondness for collecting Mongols memorabilia, and emblems and his having donned clothing such as a vest or "cut" adorned with Mongols patches.

Juan, either resisting Moore's efforts to divulge the strongest evidence he possessed against Bingham or simply lacking any substantive evidence actual criminality Bingham's part, instead implied that a law enforcement officer, who was sworn to uphold the law, had crossed the line through membership in a known criminal organization.

Multiple shortcomings in the case against Bingham were revealed in the course of the preliminary hearing.

It had been alleged that Bingham was in illegal possession of the 157 firearms found at his domicile, based, at least in part, on the consideration that O'Three Tactical, hit hard by the social distancing and other mandates that accompanied the COVID-19 pandemic, had gone out of business in June 2021, and that he was no longer a firearms dealers. In fact, however, while O'Three Tactical was closed, Bingham was yet a licensed firearms dealer.

It had further been alleged that Bingham had stolen from the sheriff's department a shotgun which had been altered to shoot not buckshot but nonlethal beanbags, as such a gun was among the 157 located at his home. He was convicted of setting both the fire on Base Line Road that was ignited at around 4:26 p.m. on September 5, 2024 that was extinguished by Scott and of setting the other fire on Base Line Road at 5:45 p.m. that went on to become the Line Fire.

Prior to trial, Halstenberg had been charged with 14 arson-related counts. Two of those were dismissed by the court.

After more than sixand-a-half days of deliberation, the jury returned guilty verdicts on nine of the twelve charges. On the three remaining charges, Count 2 - felony arson causing great bodily arising out of the Line Fire, the jury deadlocked 6 to 6; Count 4 - felony arson of a structure or forest land growing out of the Bacon Lane Fire, the jury hung 11 to 1 in favor of conviction; and on Count 5 - felony possession of material or a device for arson, the jury voted 8 in favor of conviction and 4 for acquittal.

County District Attorney's Office, on April 24, 2024 ruled there was sufficient grounds to bind Bingham, who was yet in custody, over to stand trial on one count of violating PC32625(A)-F, porting a machine gun; one count of violating PC33210-F: possession of a short-barreled rifle or shotgun; one count of violating PC487(D) (2)-F, grand theft of a firearm; five counts of violating PC18715(A) (3)-F, possession of destructive device in a private habitation; and five counts of violating PC33410-F: possession of a silencer. Each of the counts brought with it a sentencing enhancement pertaining to the crime in question having been done as an act of street gang terrorism.

Bingham was rearraigned on all 13 of those charges and their accompanying enhancements on May 10, 2024. Between the final day of his preliminary hearing on April 24, 2024 and his May 10, 2024 arraignment, Bingham was quietly released from custody. Thereafter followed four disposition hearings on July 19, August 30 November 19 in 2025 and January 31 of this year, all before Judge Harold T. Wilson, with the proceedings continued in each case. Juan is in a difficult position. He is under a set of at least three mutually exclusive orders. One of those is to continue with the case against Bingham until getting a conviction. The other is to avoid exposing what can only be described as an embarrassing compartmentalization of information in the sheriff's department. The third is to not take the case to trial, lest the overwhelming weaknesses in the case against Bingham be exposed and grounds be supplied for him to not only file and prevail on a civil suit against the department and the county but that he be reinstated as a deputy.

The charges Juan somewhat disingenuously sought to press forward with last year – that Bingham was the armorer for the Mongols – is no longer viable. Further, according to the prosecution, Bingham had, as a consequence of his ownership of O'Three Tactical, arms and armament rivaling or surpassing the guns and firepower in the possession of the department. That renders any allegations that he coveted department property and had misappropriated a shotgun it is believed O'Three Tactical had customized for the department for training purposes or actual

and implausible as to be nonsensical.

What remains the charge that Bingham was a member of a criminal organization – the Mongols – and that he assumed that role surreptitiously, without informing anyone in the department. It is not publicly known whether Bingham was on a "special" assignment in which he was seeking to insinuate himself into the fabric of the Mongols' hierarchy or was acting on his own accord. It appears, at this point, that Juan does not know whether that is the case, either, a fact he should, as the agent of justice pursuing a criminal case against Bingham, have command of. More alarming still is the prospect that Sheriff Dicus, himself, and other members of the department's managerial stratum or command echelon were kept in the dark about one of his deputy's efforts to penetrate the Mongols. With Moore pushing for full disclosure on that issue, Juan, along with his ultimate boss, District Attorney Jason Anderson, will need to make a decision on whether to continue with the prosecution or, using the justification of acting in the interest of justice, dismiss the charges against Bingham.
